The Sons of The American Legion is made up of boys and men of all ages whose parents or grandparents served in the United States military and became eligible for membership in The American Legion. All male descendants, adopted sons and stepsons of members of The American Legion and such male descendants of veterans who died in service during WW1, and December 7, 1941, to date as set forth in Article IV, Section 1 of the National Constitution of The American Legion or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service shall be eligible for membership in the Sons of The American Legion. There shall be no forms or class of membership except an active membership.
