Hello Auxiliary,

Thank you, Auxiliary members, for all you've done this year to serve and bless others. November was a very busy month. The school supplies that were collected for Give 10 for Education (155 items) were presented Nov. 1st to teacher and veteran, Joe Pientka, to distribute to the teachers at Jefferson School. A total of 800 apples were delivered on Nov. 5th for the school staff at 15 Faribault schools. Also, gift bags were presented to veterans in the area nursing homes and senior living facilities for Veterans' Day. Supplies, including insulated coffee cups, coffee, and paper products were collected and delivered to Fisher House. Forty zip lock bags were filled with hygiene products, such as deodorant, lotion, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, comb, etc., and delivered to the CRRC in Mpls. for homeless vets. Then in December, we once again handed out gift bags for Christmas to the veterans in the nursing homes and senior living residences. This month, an ambitious Valentine project netted 100 small vases and heart-shaped dishes with flowers plus 2 larger vases with bouquets were delivered to spouses, daughters, etc. of veterans.

A committee is working on plans for a fall fundraiser to replace our yearly Salad Luncheon. A number of issues simply prevent us from continuing our popular Salad Luncheon which the Auxiliary has been putting on for 30 years. A shout-out to Babe, Candy, and Pat and other faithful volunteers for all their hard work to make the Salad Luncheons so successful and enjoyable. And thank you to Pat, Winnie, Linda, and Kathy who are stepping up to make plans for a fall event.
